

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-5

[A Ordinance to Amend the Town of Louisburg’s Zoning Ordinance, Section 4 and Section 13, Location Requirements for Establishing a “Sweepstakes Operation”.]

WHEREAS:

1. The Louisburg Zoning Ordinance allows a Sweepstakes Operation throughout areas zoned B-2, Highway Business; and
2. The Town was has experienced an escalation in criminal activity at these businesses and recognize a greater threat to public safety; and
3. The matter was brought before the Town Planning Board by staff to further restrict the growth of Sweepstakes businesses acknowledging that the Town must provide locations for their establishment; and
4. After review of the above issues, an amendment to the Town of Louisburg Zoning Ordinance, Sections 4 and 13 was approved by the Town of Louisburg Planning Board on January 13, 2022.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN OF LOUISBURG TOWN COUNCIL DULY ASSEMBLED THAT:

1. Section 4, Definitions, Part B, Item 55.7 and Section 13.A.6 (a) and (b) of the Town of Louisburg Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:

ADD:

“Section 55.7, Item 6. The use shall be at least 500 feet from the following uses:

- a. residence*
- b. daycare*
- c. religious institution*
- d. park*

“Section 55.7, Item 7. The use shall be 1000 feet from another Video Sweepstakes Operation”.

“Section 55.7, Item 8. Obtain a security clearance check from the Louisburg Police Department”.

DELETE:

Section 13.A.6.(a) “Video Sweepstakes Operation”.

ADD:

Section 13.A.6.(b) Video Sweepstakes Operation”.


2. All provisions of other Town Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
3. In any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance in held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of the Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application and to the end, the provisions of this Ordinance are severable.
