

**ORDINANCE NO. 2021- 18**

**[A Ordinance to Amend the Town of Louisburg's Zoning Ordinance, Section 13, District Regulations to Add a Permitted Use.]**

**WHEREAS:**

1. The Louisburg Zoning Ordinance does not allow Restorative/Corrective Micropigmentation as a use in the Downtown Business District (B-1); and
2. The Town was approached by a local business to help establish a medically-based body image restoration practice to service clients with special needs; and
3. The matter was brought before the Town Planning Board by staff to determine whether such an addition was appropriate for the Downtown Business District; and
4. After review of the above issue, an amendment to the Town of Louisburg Zoning Ordinance, Section 13, Part A.5 (a) was unanimously approved by the Town of Louisburg Planning Board on October 14, 2021.


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN OF LOUISBURG TOWN COUNCIL DULY ASSEMBLED THAT:**

1. Section 13, Part A.5 (a) of the Town of Louisburg Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:

*"5.1 Restorative/Corrective Micropigmentation"*


2. All provisions of other Town Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.
