## **Historic Preservation Commission**

The Historic Preservation Commission reviews applications for exterior changes within the Louisburg Historic District. It is the Commission's mission to identify, protect and preserve the Historic District's architectural resources and to educate the public about those resources and preservation in general. The Commission has a quasi-judicial role which requires it to hear evidence including sworn testimony, determine relevant facts and apply the regulations as it concerns exterior changes to, or demolition of any properties, as well as any new construction. The Commission exercises this authority through the permitting process by issuing Certificates of Appropriateness for proposed work in the District. Some activities do not require Board action but can be granted by staff. The Historic Preservation Commission has seven members which meets monthly on the third Tuesday of each month absent holidays at 7:15 PM. Meetings are open to the public.
