

MINUTES
LOUISBURG TOWN COUNCIL
MAY 20, 2019

The Town Council met on Monday, May 20, 2019, at 7:30 p.m. at Town Hall. Mayor Karl Pernell and Council Members Tom Clancy, Betty Wright, Boyd Sturges, Emma Stewart and Chris Neal were present. Council Member Bill Williamson was absent.

Finance Director Sean Medlin gave the invocation.

Council Member Clancy moved that the minutes be approved. Council Member Neal seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Council Member Neal moved to add the audit presentation to the agenda. Council Member Sturges seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Mayor Pernell opened the public hearing for the purpose of rezoning the lot located at 106 North Elm Street from O&I to B-1. There was no one present to speak in favor of or in opposition to the rezoning. Council Member Sturges moved to rezone the lot located at 106 North Elm Street, Tax Parcel ID #018622, from O&I (Office & Institutional) to B-1 (Downtown Business). Council Member Stewart seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Council Member Sturges moved to appoint Johnny Williamson to the ABC Board. Council Member Wright seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Dale Place of May & Place, PA presented the audit report for the FY 2017 – 2018. He explained that the Town has no material weaknesses.

During public comment, Ann Brown, 301 Edgewood Drive, Louisburg, N. C., expressed concern with having citizens cut the grass in the public right of way between the sidewalk and the street. She said she was concerned that it would place a burden on citizens, especially older people. Ms. Brown explained that there are poles, trees, fire hydrants, etc. in the way so it isn't just a matter of pushing a lawn mower. Ernest Thomas, 304 South Bickett Boulevard, Louisburg, N. C., asked where to get the wrist band for Barbecue in the Burg. Mr. Franklin explained that they are available in the Business Office at Town Hall.

Council Member Sturges moved that the meeting be adjourned. Council Member Wright seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.
