

MINUTES
LOUISBURG TOWN COUNCIL
AUGUST 19, 2019

The Town Council met on Monday, August 19, 2019, at 7:30 p.m. at Town Hall. Mayor Karl Pernell and Council Members Chris Neal, Emma Stewart, Boyd Sturges, Betty Wright, Tom Clancy and Bill Williamson were present.

Assistant Administrator Tony King gave the invocation.

Council Member Sturges moved that the minutes be approved. Council Member Neal seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Council Member Sturges moved to approve the Asset Management Plan and Capital Improvement Plan. Council Member Wright seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Council Member Sturges moved to add to the agenda the Louisburg High School Athletic Facility property. Council Member Wright seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Council Member Sturges moved to approve Resolution 2019-2 for water line improvements. Council Member Clancy seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Council Member Clancy moved to approve Resolution 2019-3 for construction of a Water Line project described as Bullock Street Water Improvements. Council Member Stewart seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Council Member Clancy moved to approve the Certificate of Sufficiency for annexation of the Louisburg High School Athletic Facility property, Lot 1 (53.208 acres) and Lot 2 (2.919 acres), and to set the public hearing for the September Town Council meeting. Council Member Wright seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

During public comment, Ann Brown, 301 Edgewood Drive, Louisburg, N. C., said she was concerned about the recent power outage. She explained that she felt it was both expensive and dangerous. Staff made Ms. Brown aware that the outage was unavoidable as a rotten tree fell on private property knocking power lines down.

Council Member Sturges moved that the meeting be adjourned. Council Member Wright seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.
