

MINUTES
LOUISBURG TOWN COUNCIL
JANUARY 11, 2021

The Town Council met on Monday, January 11, 2021, at 7:30 p.m. at the Operations Center. Mayor Karl Pernell and Council Members Mark Russell, Tom Clancy, Betty Wright, Emma Stewart and Chris Neal were present. Council Member Boyd Sturges was absent.

Finance Director Sean Medlin gave the invocation.

Council Member Neal moved that the minutes be approved. Council Member Wright seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Council Member Stewart moved to amend the agenda to delete item #6, Authorize Town Administrator to enter into Construction and Repair Contracts. Council Member Clancy seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Mayor Pernell opened the public hearing on the Proposed Text Amendment to Establish the 911 Communications Center as a Permitted Use in the I-1 (Light Industrial) District. No one was present to speak in favor of or in opposition to the text amendment. Mayor Pernell closed the public hearing.

Mayor Pernell opened the public hearing on the Proposed Text Amendment to Establish Landscaping Supply as a Permitted Use in the A-R (Agricultural-Residential) District. No one was present to speak in favor of or in opposition to the text amendment. Mayor Pernell closed the public hearing.

Council Member Clancy moved to approve the Updated Citizen Participation Plan for the CDBG Program. Council Member Russell seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Council Member Clancy moved to approve Resolution 2021-1 to declare and dispose of surplus property located at 604 Kenmore Avenue. Council Member Neal seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Council Member Clancy moved to approve Resolution 2021-2 to award the final bid for surplus property located at 701 Kenmore Avenue. Council Member Stewart seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Council Member Clancy moved to approve the acceptance of donated property, Resolution 2021-3, owned by Samuel Odell Evans located on Bunn Road, Parcel ID #016591. Council Member Neal seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

Council Member Clancy moved that the meeting be adjourned. Council Member Wright seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.
